OMA sponsorship of Self Development Opportunities

Back in 2000 as a result of an idea of David Case the OMA Chair at the time, the OMA instigated a scheme where the OMA sponsors gap year students/current university students with Self Development Opportunities and other out of School ventures (the project) they have identified and need financial support for.

Eligibility

- current Year 13 student at Manwood's.
- recent OMs now university students.

Amount

Requests of up to £250 will be considered.

Process

- 1. Applications on the relevant form should be completed by the student outlining what the funds will be used for; how the opportunity will develop the requestor as a person; if applicable, how will this trip/activity/challenge benefit the community being visited; and what actual challenge/activity are *being* or *have been done* to raise money towards the total cost.
- 2. The form will then be submitted to the Head Teacher who reviews.
- 3. The form will then be submitted to the OMA who decide if the request is appropriate and whether the grant should be approved.
- 4. Following the project the student will submit a report about their experiences. This written report will be published on the OM Facebook page and in the OMA newsletter and shows the OMA what their money helped the student do.
