

# PESE 2026 – Kent Test Threshold Statement

Pupils have been assessed on the basis of their scores in the English, Maths and Reasoning tests (the reasoning score is for all the subsections combined).

For a Grammar assessment (G), a pupil needs:

An aggregate score of 332 or more, with no single score lower than 108.

Pupils with a Grammar assessment may be offered a place at any type of school, including a grammar school, *subject to local admission criteria*. A grammar school assessment does not guarantee that a child will get a grammar school place. The allocation process uses data from the Secondary Common Application Form to offer parents the highest available of their preferences.

Pupils with an aggregate score lower than 332 will have an H assessment, as will pupils who have scored less than 108 on one test.

Pupils with an H assessment may be offered a place at any type of school except a grammar school, subject to local admission criteria.
